Church Wardens' Update

May 2024

- Revd Jayne Crooks will lead an Ascension Day service on Thursday 9th May at 7 pm. There will be no Thursday morning service on that day.
- Revd. Jayne Crooks will lead a Holy Communion service on Thursday 16th May at 10:30 am in St Francis Chapel.
- Georgina has booked vicars , lay ministers and readers to lead our services in August and September
- The annual service of the church boiler was carried out and a minor repair was made.
- The condemned heater in the main church hall has been replaced with a second hand one donated to us by the Gas Street Church, Longbridge. This meant that we only had to pay for it to be installed.
- The boiler room has been sanitised following the flood.
- The pipework for the central heating system in the George Goodger Hall has been replaced so we can now heat that building.
- We had the hearing loop system checked on Wednesday 24th April.
- Kevin and Max came to look at the sound system on Friday 3rd May. They are coming back on Friday 17th May to start the process of updating the system.
- A plumber repaired the leak in the toilet in the main building on Friday 19th April.
- The Church Leaders Team, the Pastoral Team and the Standing Committee continue to meet once a month. These meetings help us ensure that we are well organised during the interregnum.
- Georgina is continuing to update the church website.
- Thank you to everyone who supported us at the services we provide in our local care homes. The residents really appreciated seeing you.
- We hope that the combination of weekly notice sheets, PCC minutes and Warden Updates are keeping everyone well informed about what is happening at St Anne's.
